Space Travels emerge Times Shield 'E' Division champs

MUMBAI: Space Travels won their second title in successive days, defeating Bombay Electricity Supply and Transport by three wickets at the P.J. Hindu Gymkhana here on Friday, to emerge champions in the Times Shield 'E' Division.

Space Travels had on Thursday on the Indian Airlines Invitation Cricket Tournament, defeating its Indian Airlines by 89 runs.

Put in by Space Travels, BEST did a poor start losing opener Sant Savant even before the scoreboard went into double-digits, as sorrow continued till a freeing fourth wicket stand of 91 between Vinod Karsankar and

Prashant Khanvilkar retrieved the situation for them. The duo, coming together at 74 for three, took the score to 165 before Kargankar and off-spinner Divakar Shetty oppositely and was well caught by Dilip Agarwal in the covers. Kargankar played some big strokes in his 72-ball knock of 60 which was laced with the two huge sixes and four hits to the ropes.

A second reversal followed for BEST in the same over as Khanvilkar was run out for a well made 53 which included a six and six fours and landed 52 balls. The fall of Khanvilkar's wicket was the proverbial last straw and BEST were bowled out for 209.

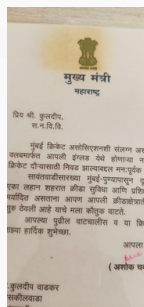
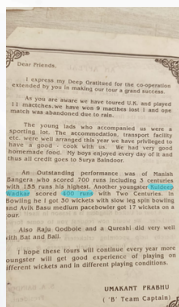
Off spinner Shetty who broke the Kargankar-Khanvilkar partnership was the stick of the bowlers

with four for 44 in nine overs. Hitesh Khambe took two wickets.

Space too had a bad start, but the second wicket partnerships of 70 runs between Nimesh Sena (23) and Kuldeep Wadkar put them on road to victory. Wadkar then added another 31 runs for the fourth wicket with Dilip Agarwal (25) before he was called by Suresh Gadekar. Wadkar's 65 was studded with five fours.

The two partnerships had well and truly put Space Travels on victory path. But they still had a few hiccups before overhauling BEST's 209. They lost three more wickets before Vinayak Gawas (12) and M. Desai (1) saw them through.

Scores: BEST 209 in 45 overs (Sandeep Kamtekar 26, Vinod Kargankar 60, Prashant Khanvilkar 53, Divakar Shetty 4 for 44) lost to Space Travels 213 for 7 in 42.4 overs (Kuldeep Wadkar 66, Dilip Agarwal 26, Manmohan Thakur 3 for 30).

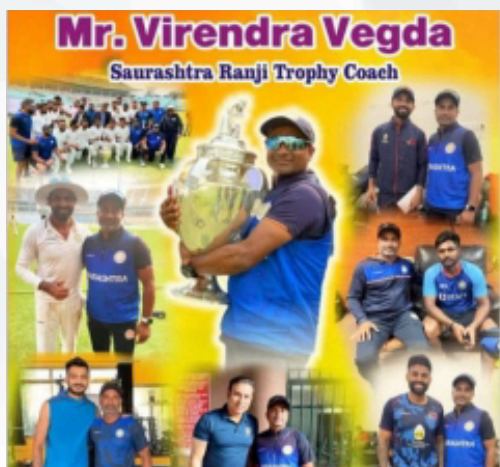
